

Assembling Your KENT Wet & Dry Vacuum Cleaner 30L

- 1. Unpack the unit completely and remove any stickers that can prevent unit operation.
- 2. Check the unit for damages. Do not use it in case of any damages.
- 3. Before switching on the unit, make sure that your home mains voltage corresponds to the unit operating voltage.

Attaching/ Detaching the Flexible Hose

a. Attaching


- Attach the flexible hose in the air intake duct on the appliance, press until it clicks into position.
- The grooves on the flexible hose cap must be aligned properly.

b. Detaching

 To detach the flexible hose from the air intake duct, rotate counter-clockwise and pull out.

- 1. Ready for use connection
- Insert the flexible tube in to the air intake duct. To do this, slide intake duct cover insert the tube and press until it clicks into the position.
 - To remove it, press down the button and pull out the hose.
- To use the blow function, just need plug the hose into blowing door.
- Connect the flexible tube, extension tube and accessories correctly.

Crevice Tool



- · For blowing the dust in the gap.







Important Instructions

 Do not operate the vacuum cleaner too close to heaters, radiators, cigarette butts, etc.









4. To unplug, do not pull the electrical cord, instead pull out the plug.



Note: If the suction pipe or extension tube is blocked, switch-off the vacuum cleaner at once. Unplug the appliance and clear the blockage. Once done, start the vacuum cleaner again.

Cleaning and Maintenance

1. Switch-off and unplug the appliance before cleaning it.

Note: Never use gasoline, solvent, abrasive cleaning agents, metal objects or hard brushes to clean the appliance.


Cleaning Filters: Your KENT Wet & Dry Vacuum Cleaner comes with a washable foam and HEPA filters for effective dry and wet cleaning.

Removing and cleaning washable foam and HEPA filter

- Remove the upper body assemble by opening the lock attached to the main body.
- 2. Gently pull the upper body to detach it from the main body.



- 3. Gently remove the filter cartridge by rotating and pulling it out.
- 4. Detach the HEPA filter from the outer foam filter by pulling it out.
- 5. Rinse filters in lukewarm water and dry them completely.



6. Once the filters are dry, put them back in reverse order.



- 7. Filters should be cleaned at least twice in a year, or when it becomes visibly soiled.
- 8. Always operate the appliance with filters installed.
- 9. Always unplug the appliance before cleaning the filters.
- 10. Do not use washing machine to rinse filters.
- 11. Do not use a hair dryer to dry it.

Storage

- If you do not intend to use the appliance for a long time, store it carefully.
- Plug out the appliance when not in use.
- Keep the appliance out of the reach of children.

Important Safety Instructions

When using an electrical appliance, basic precaution should always be followed, including the following:

- Do not leave vacuum cleaner switched on when plugged in. Unplug, when not in use and before servicing.
- 2. Use the appliance only as described in the manual.
- 3. Always use manufacturer's recommended attachments only.
- Do not use the appliance if the cord or plug is damaged or worn out. Replace the damaged cord or plug immediately.
- 5. Do not try to service the appliance on your own. Send it to an authorized service center.
- Never use the cord as a handle, close door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Keep the cord away from heated surfaces.
- 7. Do not unplug the appliance by pulling the cord. Always unplug by pulling the plug out the cord.
- 8. To avoid electric shocks, do not use the appliance with wet hands.
- 9. Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers and all parts of body away from moving parts.
- 10. Turn off all controls before unplugging.
- 11. Use extra precaution while cleaning stairs.
- 12. Do not use the appliance to pick any flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, and also do not use in the areas where they may be present.
- 13. Unplug before connecting the hose.
- 14. Do not pick up anything that is burning or leaving smoke, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ash.
- 15. Never use the appliance without the filter in place.
- 16. If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer or a service agent, or a similarly qualified person, in order to avoid a hazard.
- 17. This appliance is suitable for indoor use only.
- 18. Keep away from the reach of children.
- 19. The appliance is not designed to be used by people who are physically or mentally disabled, mentally handicapped or lack the relevant experience and knowledge, unless a person responsible for their safety uses the product with supervision and guidance.
- 20. When there is water in the dust barrel, the float will be rise and the appliance would stop working. In addition you can hear abnormal sound. The power supply haven't been cut off yet at that time. So cut off the power supply immediately. And spill the water in the barrel. Restart the machine.
- 21. When the vacuum is overturned, the float will rise. In that case, cut off the power supply and upturn the vacuum.
- If you run the vacuum or leave it alone while the float is risen, it may damage the motor and lead to fire.

Troubleshooting

Problem	Possible Cause	Possible Solutions
The appliance does not switch on.	The power cord is not firmly plugged into the socket. There's no power in the main supply.	Plug in the unit firmly. Check the fuse or cutout switch. Replace fuse or reset the switch. Call authorised service center.
The appliance has weak suction power.	1. The filters are blocked.	 Switch off the cleaner and disconnect the cleaner from the main power supply. Remove the filter and clean them. Clean the remaining dust inside the dust canister and fitter cone.
The hose or brush does not pick any dust.	The hose is chocked or there's some blockage in the brush.	 Switch off the cleaner and disconnect the cleaner from the main power supply. Remove the hose and/or brush. Remove any blockage.
